#### Financial Reports: 6.

Presentation of the Annual Report and Accounts.

Motion: "That the Annual Accounts 2020 be adopted." Kevin Stracey/Ross Sweet **CARRIED** 

Kevin Stracey presented the Treasurer's report – written report in Between the Spires, and accounts presented via email or available at the meeting. The Treasurer noted that accounts have been signed off by the auditors.

Reiterated that the result in 2020 was very unusual and was impacted by COVID-19. Pleased to be able to report we were able to maintain Cathedral's ministry and income. Fewer visitors with the shop shut. Noted that without Commonwealth Government's Job Keeper program the Cathedral would have been in a more difficult position.

Presentation of Budget for 2021 b.

The Treasurer noted there have been more imponderables than usual for this budget. With an abundance of caution the Cathedral Council has set a budget with considerable deficit. However, the Treasurer noted that the situation was looking more hopeful now, but there is a need to be cautious.
